ITEM IDENTIFICATION:

Proposal for the closure of a series of UTSC undergraduate programs to which admissions has been suspended

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

The Committee on Academic Policy and Programs approves the closures of undergraduate programs within an existing degree, as defined by the University of Toronto Quality Assurance Process. (*AP&P Terms of Reference, Section 4.4.b.i.*)

PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

HIGHLIGHTS:

This is a proposal for the closure of a number of UTSC undergraduate Specialist, Major and Minor programs with very low enrolments. Admissions to these programs was suspended between 2009-10 and 2011-12 as indicated in the proposal and it is anticipated that all students in progress will have graduated by the full closure date of June 2015.

The proposal identifies the courses and programs which continue to be offered and can accommodate students with interests in these areas.

The closure of the programs below was approved by the UTSC Academic Committee on January 29, 2013 which constitutes the final level of approval at the Divisional level.
