- UTM Registrar and Director of Enrolment Management is Lorretta Neebar; The following searches are ongoing: Chief Administrative Officer and Vice Principal, Research
- New unit in the UTM Office of the Vice-Principal, Academic & Dean (VPA&D): Academic Planning, Policy and Analytics Neil Neebar and two additional staff are

moving from the Office of the Registrar and the unit will support the VPA&D, the Registrar and the Dean of Student Affairs.

- Global Scholars program: UTM will have four streams, co-curricular record and academic certificate programs, and will emulate a summer program like Middlebury internationally renowned Summer Language Schools.
- The Centre for Medicinal Chemistry will be moving forward a proposal to be established as a research focused Extra-Departmental Unit-C, (EDU-C) [CMC has previously been described in Governance]
- With the support of the Vice-President of University Operations, UTM is now considering how to move forward to build student residence space.
- Department Chairs continue to deliberate about Responsibility Centered Management (RCM) budget models.
- First part of Indigenous Task Force report has been received; "peace park" (contemplation and ceremonial space) [<u>Academic plan and Indigenous Task Force previously described in Governance</u>]
- UTM Website redesign has been initiated, led by the Office of Communications and Information & Instructional Technology Services (I&ITS).
