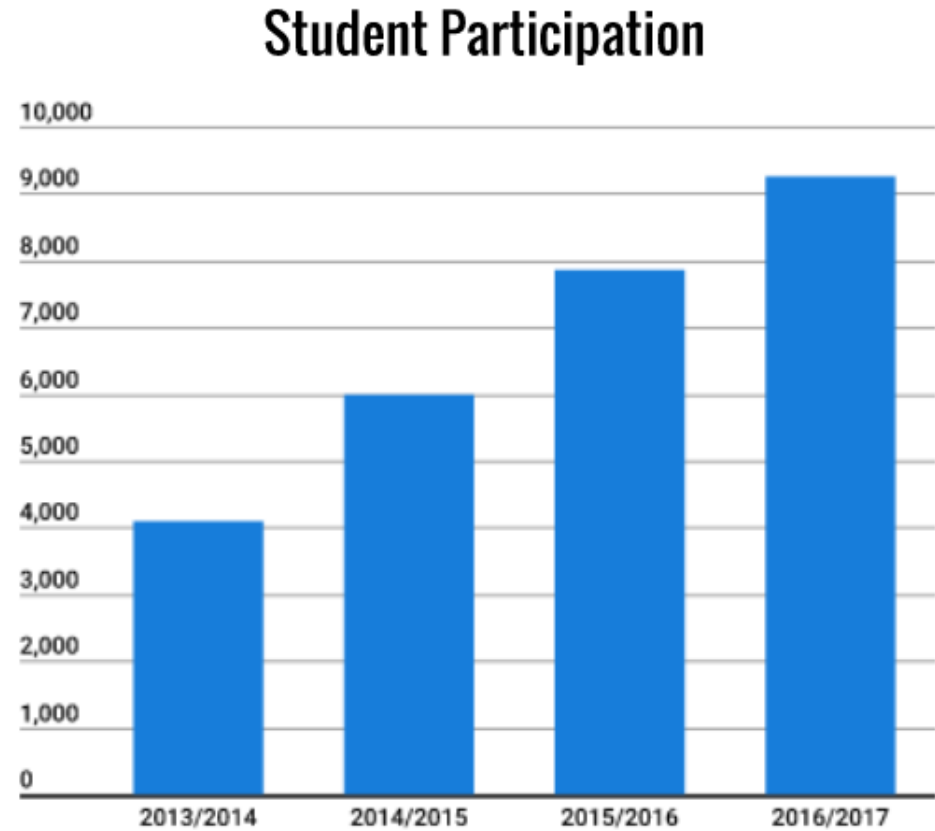
How many applications do we get from the US?

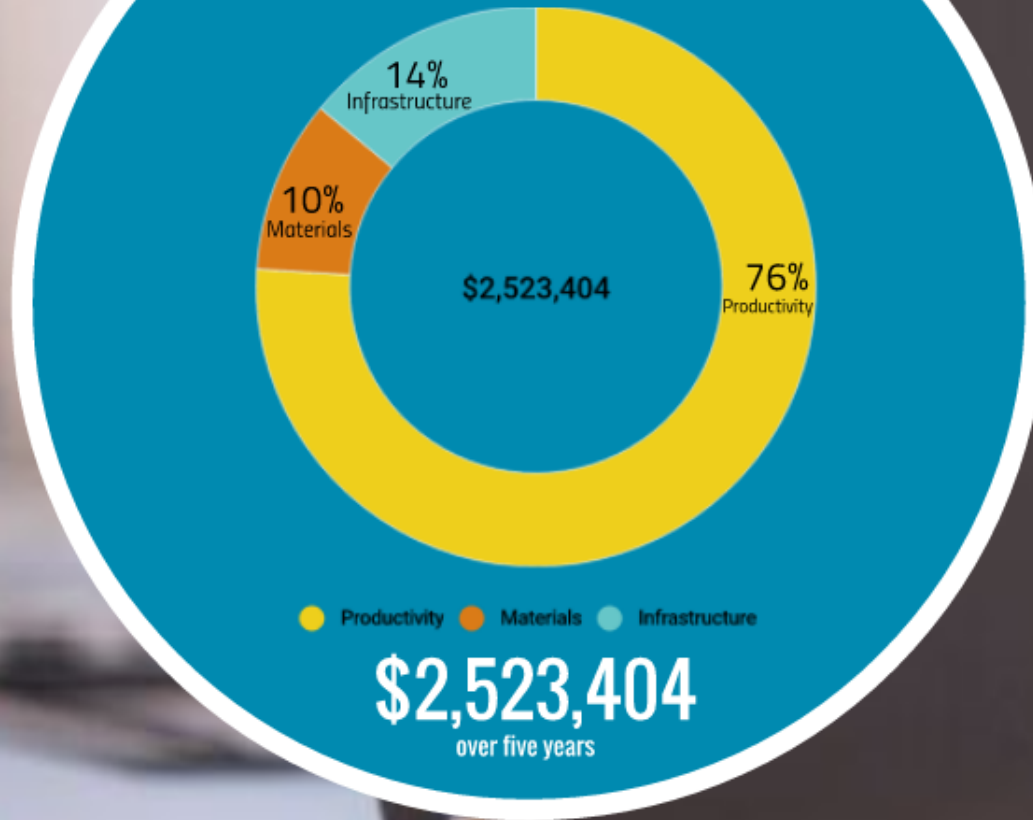
