HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) Visits and Orders

During this reporting period, April 1 – June 30, 2019 there were 3 visits from the MOL, 3 at St George regarding 2 employee injuries and an anonymous complaint. No orders issued.

2. Regulatory Visits

During this reporting period there was 1 regulatory visit. The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) conducted an inspection of the waste licence on March 19, 2019. In the preliminary report, there were 3 minor non-compliance that were noted have since been complied with. Final report not yet received.

3. Incidents Abroad Relating to Students

During this reporting period there were two emergency incidences abroad involving students. Both related to personal illness.

4. Summary

In summary, based on the reports I have received through the operation of our occupational health and safety policy, and to the best of my knowledge, the University is in compliance with its health and safety obligations.
