RE: Call for Nominations for the Advisory Committee on the Appointment of a Vice-President and Provost

On June 30, 2020, Professor Cheryl Regehr will be completing her [current term](#) as Vice-President and Provost. She has been serving in the role since September 2, 2013. Professor Regehr is eligible for reappointment.

I am writing to call for nominations of individuals to serve on the Advisory Committee for the Vice-President and Provost. The membership of the Advisory Committee will comprise:

- 6 to 8 members of the teaching staff, including academic administrators,
- 1 member of the administrative staff,
- 1 alumnus/a,
- 1 Lieutenant Governor-in-Council member of the Governing Council and
- 2 students.

The Committee's first task will be to undertake a review and advise me on the Office of the Vice-President and Provost and on priorities that should be considered for the Provost. Given that Professor Regehr is eligible to be re-appointed, the Committee will also consider whether to recommend her re-appointment.

Ms Sheree Drummond, Secretary of the Governing Council, will serve as secretary to the Committee. Mr. Anwar Kazimi, Deputy Secretary, will also provide support.
