HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) Visits and Orders

During this reporting period there were two visits from the MOL at St George regarding a follow-up visit related to an employee injury and an anonymous complaint. No orders issued.

2. Regulatory Visits

During this reporting period there was one regulatory visit by Transport Canada, who do routine inspections regarding management of hazardous materials related to both bio/rad lab waste. They conducted an inspection of Transportation of Dangerous Goods at the St George Campus on September 9, 2019. Report not yet received.

3. Incidents Abroad Relating to Students

During this reporting period there was one incident which occurred during the summer semester involving 6 undergraduate students evacuated from Rwanda due to an Ebola risk.

In summary, based on the reports I have received through the operation of our occupational health and safety policy, and to the best of my knowledge, the University is in compliance with its health and safety obligations.
