Provincial Government Ancillary Fee Changes

New Framework released March 29, 2019 Allows for mandatory fee collection for essential services:

Athletics and Recreation Career Services Student buildings Health and Counselling Academic Support Student ID cards Student Achievement & Records **Financial Aid Offices** Campus Safety

Health and Dental plans can be charged on a compulsory basis, but must allow an opt-out with proof of pre-existing coverage.

Student Transit Passes may be compulsory if the fee was established prior to Jan. 17, 2019.
