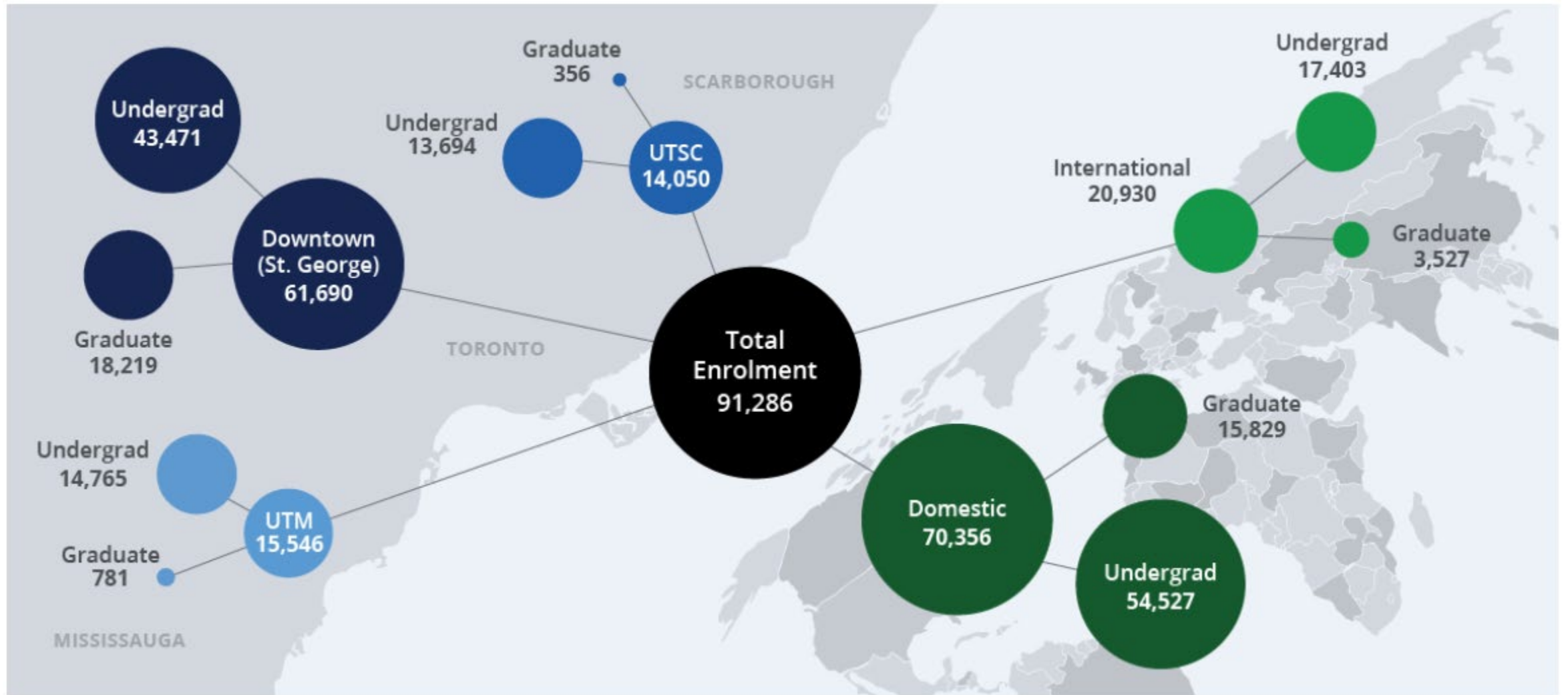

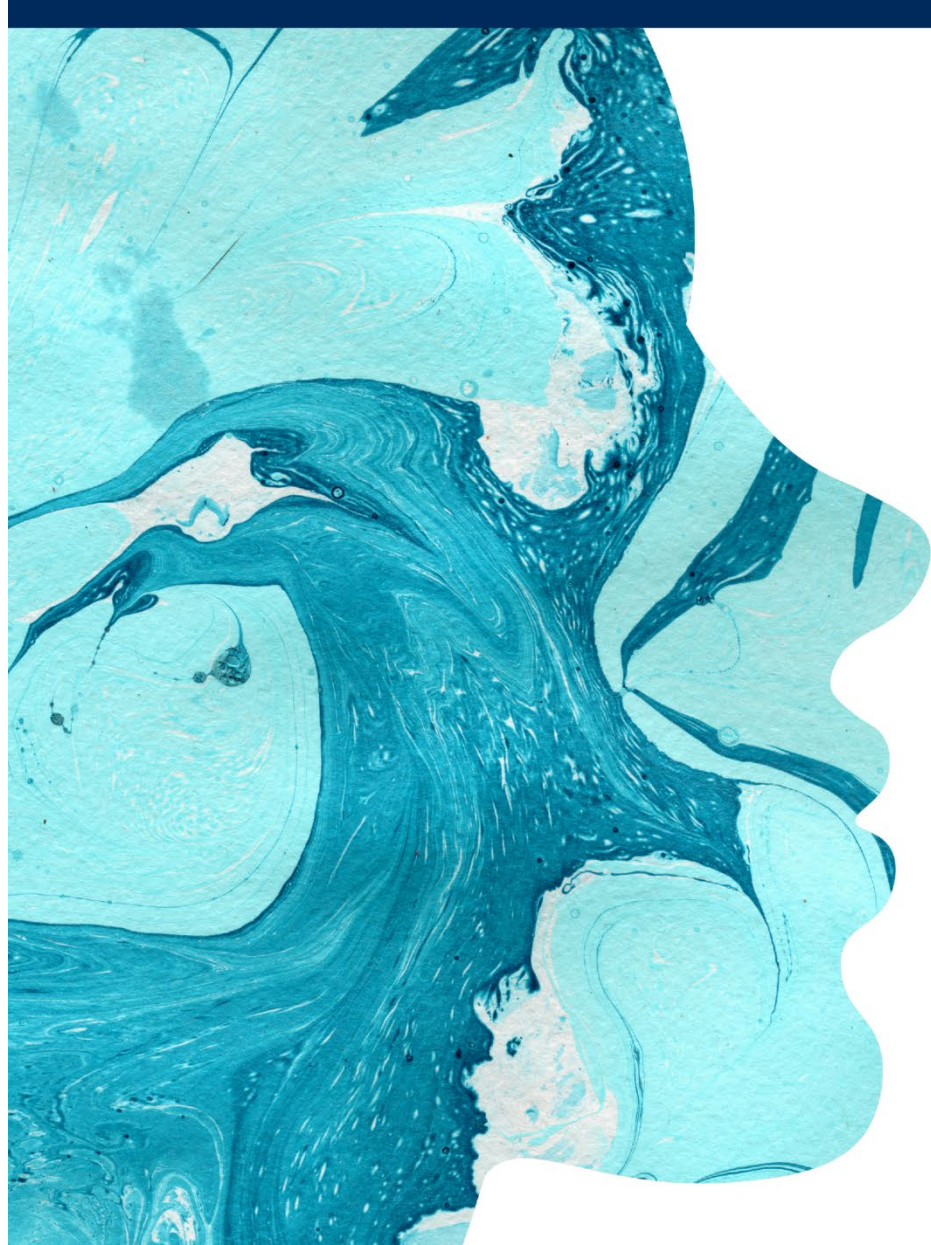

Provincial Government Ancillary Fee Changes

New Framework released March 29, 2019
