HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) Visits and Orders

During this reporting period, October 1 - December 31, 2019, there were two visits from the Ministry of Labour at the St. George campus, two visits to UTSC and one visit to UTM. No orders were issued.

2. Regulatory Visits

During this reporting period there was one regulatory visit to UTSC from the City of Toronto regarding water inspection, due to a glycol spill. A report was provided to the inspector. No further action.

3. Incidents Abroad Relating to Students

During this reporting period there were three incidences which occurred, two regarding personal medical conditions and one requiring the evacuation of undergraduate students due to political instability.
