What is the BCSSE?

 Institutions administer the Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement (BCSSE) to incoming students prior to the start of fall or winter classes. BCSSE collects data about entering students' <u>prior academic and</u> <u>co-curricular experiences</u>, as well as their <u>expectations for participating in</u> <u>educationally purposeful activities</u> during the coming academic year.









Who are UTM's incoming students?


























Academic expectations in 1st year

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


Aggregate level
