**1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) Visits and Orders**

During this reporting period, January 1 – March 31, 2020 there were five visits from the Ministry of Labour to St George, two orders issued regarding compliance of one Joint Health and Safety Committee. There was one visit to UTM, no orders issued.

**2. Regulatory Visits**

During this reporting period there were no regulatory visits.

### **3. Incidents Abroad Relating to Students**

During this reporting period, due to COVID-19, the Safety Abroad Office facilitated the repatriation of 648 students (182 Graduate students, 466 undergraduate students) from numerous countries around the world.
