**1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) & Public Health Visits and Orders**

During this reporting period there was 1 visit (UTM) from the MOL to review measures and procedures implemented to manage reported Covid-19 positive cases and to follow up on a complaint. No orders issued.

Other: During this reporting period Toronto Public Health (TPH) notified the university of an anonymous complaint filed regarding allegations of mask non-compliance on campus. No follow up required by TPH.
