



2021 Elections of the Governing Council and Its Bodies

Filing of Notice of Intent to Appeal and Appeals

The [Election Guidelines 2021](#) states:

- (a) A candidate may appeal any matter arising from the conduct of the elections during the Election Period to the Election Overseers, including the announcement of results, by filing a Notice of Intent to Appeal in accordance with the following requirements: (i) The form of Notice of Intent to Appeal that must be used will be available online from the Office of the Governing Council’s Election website. (ii) The Notice of Intent to Appeal must be filed by email to the Office of the Governing Council by 12:00 noon on Wednesday, February 24, 2021. EMAIL ADDRESS: governing.council@utoronto.ca
- (b) The Election Overseers shall review the appellant’s grounds for an appeal as outlined in the Notice of Intent to Appeal filed by the appellant and the Election Overseers may: (i) dismiss the appeal if it decides that the grounds do not have merit; (ii) grant the appeal without a hearing if it decides that the grounds have merit; or (iii) hold a hearing in a manner and in accordance with such procedures as it may determine to be appropriate and render a decision thereafter.
- (c) The Election Overseers shall render a decision by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 25, 2021.
- (d) The decision of the Election Overseers shall be final and not subject to any further review or appeal.
