**JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:**

**PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:**

The *Tuition Fee Schedule for Self-funded Programs 2020-21* was approved by the Governing Council at its meeting on April 2, 2020.

**HIGHLIGHTS:**

The University offers a number of programs that are not funded under the Ministry's operating grants program, and, as a consequence, their fees are not regulated. The programs are self-funded. Tuition fees for these programs are set at levels necessary to eliminate or avoid budget deficits. Annual changes in tuition fees reflect not only inflation but may also reflect variations in real costs

as programs and services change. The proposed fee levels and year-over-year increases for self-funded programs are described in Table 1.

**FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:**

Revenue projections for self-funded programs are included in the *Budget Report 2021-22 and Long Range Budget Guidelines 2021-22 to 2025-26*.
