➤ Growth Chambers were design and constructed for a new hire in Biology




Office Renovation Project for IT&S

➤ The CAO/Principals office was re-designed and renovated to accommodate additional staff








Anthropology Sleep Lab

for a recent hire in Anthropology






Kaneff UTM Management Program Project



Elevator Modernization

Project Status : Complete September 2020

- Cabs 6 & 7 in the Davis Wing serve both J and K Blocks
- Original to the Davis Building circa 1970
- low-rise passenger elevators that were outdated
- Prone to frequent service issues
- Unreliable and unavailable
- Modernization ensures:
 - code compliance
 - Accessibility
 - > Increased reliability



Switchgear Upgrade Projects

Project Status: Complete January 2020

- ➤ This equipment provides power to mechanical equipment that provides chilled water, hot water and steam as well as feeds equipment that distributes electricity to all campus buildings
- End of Life installed in 1960.
- Aged circuit breakers pose a risk of failure



CUP Slab Rehabilitation Project

Project Status: Construction May 2021

- CUP was built in 1960's
- > Slab is cracking in multiple areas and water penetration has exposed rebar.
- Structural assessment has Indicated widespread corrosion related to deterioration
- Testing has revealed that a full slab and structural beam replacement is necessary to prevent structural failure.





Research RO System Replacement Project

Project Status: Commissioning April 2021

- Current system is 30 yrs old
- Gravity fed system not efficient
- > End of Life
- Improvements in technology and research demand for capacity has increased
- Improved water quality
- > Supports research needs





Schreiberwood Transformer Upgrade

Project Status : Complete July 2020

- Original ant at end of life 40 years old
- Project replaced 3 transformers that distribute power to Schreiberwood town homes and Oscar Peterson Hall
- New transformers will provide more redundancy to residence
