## Human, Intellectual, and Innovation Capital Raise the Community

- Innovation clusters are better for residents, companies, and developers: "Americans with high school degrees who work in communities dominated by innovative industries make more, on average, than the college graduates working in communities dominated by [traditional] industries"
- Increased talent and innovation draw Foreign Direct Investment
- Sustainable design attracts high value companies

Example: Evolv1 in Waterloo's David Johnston Park is Canada's **first Zero Carbon Building ,** attracting tenants such as EY, Borealis AI, and Wilfrid Laurier University Foreign Direct Investment into Canada
