1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) & Public Health Visits and Orders

During this reporting period the MOL contacted us 3 times, twice regarding measures and procedures implemented to manage reported Covid-19 positive cases at St George, and once regarding the state of a parking garage spot. No orders issued.

During this reporting period there were no local public health authority visits.

2. Regulatory Visits
