#### 1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) & Public Health Visits and Orders

During this reporting period (July 1 to September 30, 2021), the Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) contacted the University 3 times at St. George campus: twice regarding employee complaints and once regarding the outcome of a previously reported outbreak of COVID-19. MOL issued no orders to the University on these occasions.

During this same period, Toronto Public Health contacted us once regarding an anonymous complaint. No action was required by the University.
