




- Developed by U of T Entrepreneurship (UTE) and Innovation and Partnerships Office (IPO) inside VPRI
- The Intellectual Property (IP) Education Program is a free, interactive, self-paced series of topics / modules course consisting of two levels:
 - Level 1: IP Foundations
 - Level 2: IP Strategy and Application
- Level 1 is available on four different platforms: Quercus, Open U Toronto, E-Campus Ontario: Open Library and Ministry of Colleges and Universities
- Recognized on student's Co-Curricular Record
- Endorsed by the Ontario Ministry of Colleges and Universities, Level 1 is now available publicly on the IP Education microsite developed by UTE

 - Industry and sector agnostic, providing access to funding opportunities, investors, resources, mentorship and more
- Celebrating Black History Month
 - 9 events with 1,200 attendees
 - Dedicated webpage featuring Black founders, BHM events, news and more
 - BHM social media campaign to celebrate Black founders


