

### **ACADEMIC BUSINESS REVIEW (ABR)**

- Creation of UTM's balanced budget for the next five years achieved through implementation of various budget reduction strategies
- Budget reflects that UTM still needs to grow: to continue to develop our campus infrastructure and employ new staff and faculty; to advance the priorities of UTM's Strategic Framework; and to deliver for our students and communities an experience that matches U of T's global reputation for excellence

#### **BUDGET PLANNING COMMITTEE**

- Created in 2021-22 to support alignment to key Strategic Framework priorities, the University's Strategic Mandate Agreement, the Academic Plan, and the Campus Master Plan
- Meets monthly to provide support for budget development and management processes
