HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) & Public Health Visits

During this reporting period (April 1 to June 30, 2022) the Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) visited the University of Toronto Scarborough on four occasions: three times regarding an injured worker (six orders were issued), and one visit as follow-up for this incident (no orders were issued). There was one visit to the University of Toronto Mississauga regarding an employee injury, with no orders issued. There was one follow-up visit to the St. George campus, with no orders issued.
