# 1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) & Public Health Visits and Orders

During this reporting period (July 1 to September 30, 2022) the Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) visited the University eight times and issued no orders. The MOL visited UTSC on six occasions: four regarding an electrical safety incident, one regarding an injury involving a dolly, and one related to a complaint about eating areas. There were two visits to St. George: one

regarding a slip-and-fall injury and one regarding a reported occupational illness (Noise-induced hearing loss). There were no visits to UTM during the reporting period.
