

UPDATE ON ACADEMIC INTEGRITY INITIATIVES

CASE NUMBERS:

- Three AI staff (2 permanent), 6 DD's.
 - Implemented new TT (traffic ticket) system to process first offence cases more quickly
 - Case Numbers:
 - April, 2022:
 - 278 active cases in April 2022; 96 were 2020 and older
 - January, 2023:
 - 28 active cases (decrease of 90%)*
 - No remaining pre-2021 cases (decrease of 100%)
- *new cases are coming from the Dec, 2022 exam period

UPDATE ON ACADEMIC INTEGRITY INITIATIVES – CONT'D

NEW INITIATIVES:

- Focus on education/prevention – new CTL resources for students and faculty
- Introduction of AI resource modules on all Quercus course pages by summer 2023
- Standardized syllabus template wording
- Development of new AI case management software system to replace use of three different platforms – Summer 2023 pilot with Fall 2023 roll-out
 - Instructor upload of documentation to one portal, automatic diversion to Chair or Chair's representative for cases less than 10% and first offence, enhanced resolution tracking, seamless integration with related RO functions (e.g., petitions and grades)

NEW CHALLENGES:

- Addressing the use of technologies for compromising the integrity of in-person exams (e.g., buttonhole cameras and earpieces) and Artificial Intelligence tools for in-term assignments (e.g., ChatGPT)
