BACKGROUND

- Work had started in 2017 with the Government of Ontario to create a medical in Scarborough to support the growing population and the lack of health care resources in the region
- Struck the project planning committee June 2020 for the SAMIH project
- In early 2022 the Provincial government announced funding for the project.
- The province will fund operating costs but capital will be provided through the university and Donors
- The first \$25m donation was secured in sept 2022
- September 2022: Confirmation that University of Toronto will receive funding for up to 30 additional undergraduate seats and 45 additional post graduate positions as well as 300 new health related life science graduates to support the new Scarborough Academy of Medicine and Integrated Health (SAMIH).
- September 2022: CaPS Executive Approval September 2022 to engage consultants to support the Design build request for proposals and bidder stipends




