Oversight Role: Office of Vice-Provost Students

PROCESS

Fee collection and related accountabilities

APPROVAL

Fees are first vetted through the Vice Provost Student's office prior submission to CAC, to ensure proposed increases are appropriate and adhere to the rules governing fee increases for the various societies, such as limits imposed by referendums.

INCREASES

Many student society fees are increased by CPI, defined by year-over-year change in consumer prices for Ontario as measured by Statistics Canada as of December 31 of the previous year. (Policy for Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees)

COMMUNICATION

Department of Student Life & Office of Student Experience & Wellbeing liaises between Student Societies & Vice Provost Students to assist in coordination of the process.
