ITEM IDENTIFICATION:

Category 5, Cost Recovery Ancillary Fees, 2023-24; and Category 6, Administrative User Fees and Fines, 2023-24

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

Pursuant to Section 5.11 (b) the Business Board has responsibility for academic ancillary fees.

The University's *Policy on Ancillary Fees* makes provision for a Category 5: University Schedule of Cost Recovery Fees and a Category 6: University Schedule of User Fees and Fines.

Under the *Policy*, fees shown on the schedules may be adjusted annually by administrative authority of the Vice President, Operations & Real Estate Partnerships, provided that the adjustments relate to changes in the cost of the materials or services provided. These changes are to be reported annually to the Business Board for information. The introduction or removal of a Schedule 6 User Fee or Fine is submitted to the Business Board for review and approval.

PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

The 2022-23 fees were considered by the Business Board at its March 15, 2022 meeting.

HIGHLIGHTS:

Ancillary fees are fees charged to pay for services, materials, and activities that are not supported by operating grants, capital grants, or tuition fees. The University of Toronto introduced a Policy on Ancillary Fees in 1995 (the *Policy*), which translates the Ancillary Fee Guidelines provided by the Ministry of Colleges, and Universities (MCU) into the University of Toronto context.

There are several factors putting upward pressure on ancillary fees for 2023-24:

- This year, many learning activities and services supported by ancillary fees returned to regular levels for the first time since the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result, a number of fees were reassessed for 2023-24 to reflect the current and projected costs of operations, in particular given the current high inflation environment.
- For 2023-24, divisions were encouraged to consider a best practice approach of applying smaller, annual cost-related increases to ancillary fees versus much larger periodic step-function increases. This reduces the impact on students from large increases and helps keep fees in-line with annual cost inflation. The result of this is a higher proportion of ancillary fees increasing in 2023-24 compared to previous years.

In total, there are 864 fees in Category 5 and 271 fees in Category 6. Of these, roughly 32% (368) will remain unchanged or will be reduced in 2023-24, 66 fees are new, and 520 fees will see an inflationary increase of 5% or less, of which 392 fees will increase by only 2% or less. There are 181 fees that will increase by more than 5%, primarily due to factors such as the current high inflation environment, elevated input costs reflecting post-COVID-19 market conditions, added cost of materials or services due to curriculum changes, updated vendor prices, and lower levels of planned enrolments against fixed costs. Some fees are being increased for the first time in several years or increased from a low amount. There are 69 fees that are being removed from the schedules at the requests of the applicable divisions.

Category 5 Cost Recovery Fees and Category 6 Administrative User Fees and Fines have been reviewed in the context of Ministry of Colleges and Universities existing Guidelines and the University's *Policy on Ancillary Fees*. The fees are deemed to be in compliance.

The complete schedules of Category 5 and 6 fees are included in Appendices B and C of the attached report.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Cost Recovery Ancillary Fees and Administrative User Fees and Fines are set at a level to cover the cost of the services provided.

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Background

Ancillary fees are fees charged to pay for services, materials, and activities that are not supported by operating grants, capital grants, or tuition fees. The University of Toronto introduced a Policy on Ancillary Fees in 1995 (the Policy), which translates the Ancillary Fee Guidelines provided by the Ministry of Colleges and Universities (MCU) into the University of Toronto context.

The Policy defines six categories of fees that may be established by the University:

- **Category 1: Services Provided by the University** includes fees for institution-wide and College-based student services, health services, athletics and recreation, and Hart House.
- **Category 2: Services Provided by Student Organizations** includes the costs of operating student societies and the cost of services provided by them, such as fees in support of student-initiated health plans, communications, and social and cultural services. The University acts as a collection agent for the student organization, but the fees are passed directly to the respective student organizations.
- **Category 3: Student Levies for Specific, Limited Projects** includes fees established by student organizations for specific projects within the University which are designated by them. The University acts as a collection agent for the student organization, but the fees are either passed directly to the student organization or to a restricted account for the purpose designated by the organization.
- **Category 4: Academic Surcharges for Extraordinary Cost** includes optional fees for extra services beyond those normally provided and required by a degree program or course, such as studio fees, cinema screening fees, laundry fees, or computing fees when additional computing time is made available to students at their option.
- **Category 5: Cost Recovery Ancillary Fees** include fees for publications, case studies, laboratory manuals, field trips, clothing, equipment, goods or services provided to students for their exclusive use; charges for various forms of non-credit remedial instruction; and materials, services, or licenses where the University acts as a broker with a vendor on behalf of students.
- **Category 6: Administrative User Fees and Fines** include fees for special registration arrangements, optional copies of records, special arrangements relating to examinations, placement fees, library fines, registration fees, and other services.

Category 5 Cost Recovery Ancillary Fees and Category 6 Administrative User Fees and Fines may be adjusted annually by administrative authority of the Vice President, Operations and Real Estate Partnerships, provided that changes relate to cost of materials or services provided. These changes are reported annually to the Business Board for information. The schedules of Category 5 Cost Recovery Fees and Category 6 Administrative User Fees and Fines for 2023-24 are attached.

There are several factors putting upward pressure on ancillary fees for 2023-24:

- This year, many learning activities and services supported by ancillary fees returned to regular levels for the first time since the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result, a number of fees were reassessed for

2023-24 to reflect the current and projected costs of operations, in particular given the current high inflation environment.

The University also publishes a schedule of fees charged to individuals who are not enrolled as UofT students, such as application and admission deferral fees for applicants, and licensing and degree verification fees for alumni. These fees are not subject to MCU ancillary fee guidelines or the *Policy* described above. These fees are provided for information in appendix D.

Category 6 Fees for Approval

The introduction or removal of Category 6 fees requires approval by Business Board. The proposed changes for 2023-24 are outlined in Tables 1 and 2 below.

There are some fees that warrant highlighting for this year's cycle:

- Registrar offices across the University provide multiple services to students related to their registration and academic records with the University. Such costs are recovered through fees under Category 6. Historically, these fees were listed separately by individual divisions with at times varying fee levels for similar services. To streamline fees assessment and administration, the Office of the University Registrar reviewed the 2022-23 schedules in consultation with the divisional registrars and is proposing one consolidated fee for each service for 2023-24 to be added to the General – University Registrar schedule. Any division in future may refer to and charge the University-wide listed fees for the following services: Photocopies of student records (\$15), External examination arrangement (\$50) and Clerical check of marks (\$15). As a result, the prior fees that were listed at the divisional level are proposed to be removed from the schedules.
- The Faculty of Dentistry is proposing to add three new clinical placement fees for 2023-24 that will recover the cost of clinical placement services offered to its undergraduate and graduate students. These fees range between \$458 and \$1,346, depending on year of study and if the clinical placements are in an internal clinic or both internal and external clinics. These cost-recovery fees will support the administrative staff and overhead costs in the clinical placement office who liaise with internal and external clinics, recruit and on-board clinical instructors, and match clinical instructors to student clinic rotations. Similar placement fees are assessed in other divisions to support the costs of clinical, internship, co-op and PEY placement services.
- The fees schedule for 2023-24 includes three new entries as part of the multi-year phase-in of placement fees for the Arts & Science Internship (ASIP) and APSC Professional Experience Co-op programs. The total cost is spread across Years 2-4 of these 5-year programs. The proposed new fees for 2023-24 comprise the final work term placement installments: \$1,800 for students in APSC and \$1,860 (2 x \$930) for ASIP students. The fees are slightly different between the two programs because of the difference in scale of the programs from which to recover costs.

Appendix A: Policy on Ancillary Fees (1995)

In addition to the Tuition Fee Schedule, there shall be a Schedule of Ancillary Fees. The schedule will be organised as follows:

1.0 Student Services provided by the University¹

1.1 Student Services; 1.2 Health Services; 1.3 Athletics; 1.4 Hart House; and 1.5 Constituent College Fees (excludes college library fees which are prohibited)

2.0 Student organizations and services provided by such organizations²

2.1 Student society fees including any portion thereof in support of student-initiated health plans and communications; 2.2 Social and cultural services (excluding Hart House); and 2.3 Other fees levied by student organizations to cover the costs of operating the organizations or services provided by them. The University may act as a collection agent for the student organization, but the fees will be passed directly to the respective student organizations.

3.0 Student levies for specific, limited projects³

Student organizations may establish levies for specific, limited projects within the University which are designated by them. The University may act as a collection agent for the student organization, but the fees will either be passed directly to the respective student organization or to a restricted account for the purpose(s) designated by the organization.

All fees in Categories 1.0, 2.0 and 3.0 that are compulsory will be governed by the University's Policy on Compulsory Non-academic Incidental Fees. The application of the Policy will not preclude the assignment of Category 3.0 Student levies for specific, limited projects to academic purposes.

4.0 Academic surcharges for extraordinary cost

4.1 Studio Fees; 4.2 Cinema Screening Fees; 4.3 Laundry; and 4.4 Computing Fees. Compulsory ancillary fees normally may not be levied for these services. The only exception may be for extra services beyond those normally provided and required by a degree program or course, as for example when additional computing time is made available to students at their option.

5.0 Cost Recoveries⁴

5.1 Publications, case studies, laboratory manuals; 5.2 Field trips; 5.3 Clothing; 5.4 Equipment purchases that become the property of students; 5.5 Equipment rentals that, for the period of rental, come into the individual possession of students; and 5.6 Other goods and services provided individually to students for their exclusive use. Charges for various forms of non-credit remedial

¹ All fees in this category are compulsory. The Ministry of Colleges and Universities' Compulsory Ancillary Fee Policy requires that protocols be established in order to increase or add new fees to this category.

² In accordance with the Ministry of Colleges and Universities' Compulsory Ancillary Fee Policy fees established by student governments, including those resulting from referenda sponsored by them are excluded from the protocol requirement.

³ Such fees must be approved by student referenda as required by the Ministry of Colleges and Universities' Compulsory Ancillary Fee Policy. These fees are exempt from the protocol requirement of the Ministry's policy.

⁴ Such fees, whether or not they are compulsory, are exempt from the Ministry of Colleges and Universities' Compulsory Ancillary Fee Policy protocol requirement.

instruction, if provided, may be included here; and 5.7 Materials, services, or licenses where the University acts as a broker with a vendor for the student.⁵

Fees charged to recover costs must relate to those costs, and may not exceed them, or a reasonable estimate of them. The only cost recoveries that may be charged are those shown on the University Schedule of Cost Recovery Fees, which initially was the list of cost recoveries shown in the University's submission to the Ministry of Training & Education, February 16, 1987. The fees shown on the Schedule may be adjusted annually by administrative authority (the Vice President, Operations and Real Estate Partnerships) provided that the adjustments relate to changes in cost, and are for goods and services that comply with the Policy on Ancillary Fees. All changes shall be reported annually to the Business Board for information.

6.0 Administrative user fees and fines⁶

6.1 Registration fees; 6.2 Records and documents (excluding diplomas and certificates, for which no fee may be charged except for replacements); 6.3 Examination and grades (excluding initial grade reports, for which no fee may be charged); 6.4 Co-op program placement fees; 6.5 Library fines; and 6.6 Other administrative user fees or fines shown on the University Schedule of Administrative User Fees and Fines.

Administrative user fees must relate to the costs of the services provided, and may not exceed them, or reasonable estimates of them. The only administrative user fees and fines that may be charged are those shown on the University Schedule of Administrative User Fees and Fines. The fees and fines shown on the Schedule may be adjusted annually by administrative authority (the Vice President, Operations and Real Estate Partnerships), provided that the adjustments relate to the costs of the services provided. All changes shall be reported annually to the Business Board for information. The introduction or removal of a fee from the Schedule must be submitted to the Business Board for review and approval.

7.0 General program support

Other than tuition fees, no fees may be levied for general program support, except as provided for in Category 3.0, student levies for specific, limited projects.

8.0 System Wide Fees⁷

8.1 University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP). Such fees are established through a formal agreement under which students at all Ontario universities pay a comparable fee for a comparable service. Such fees are exempt from the Ministry of Colleges and Universities' Compulsory Ancillary Fee Policy protocol requirement.

⁵ This is a new category introduced by the Ministry of Colleges and Universities. For the University of Toronto, this category replicates Category 5.4.

⁶ All fees in this category are exempt from the Ministry of Colleges and Universities' Compulsory Fee Policy protocol requirement.

⁷ This is a new category introduced by the Ministry of Colleges and Universities policy. The UHIP fee is actually a Council of Ontario Universities fee which is reported here for information.
