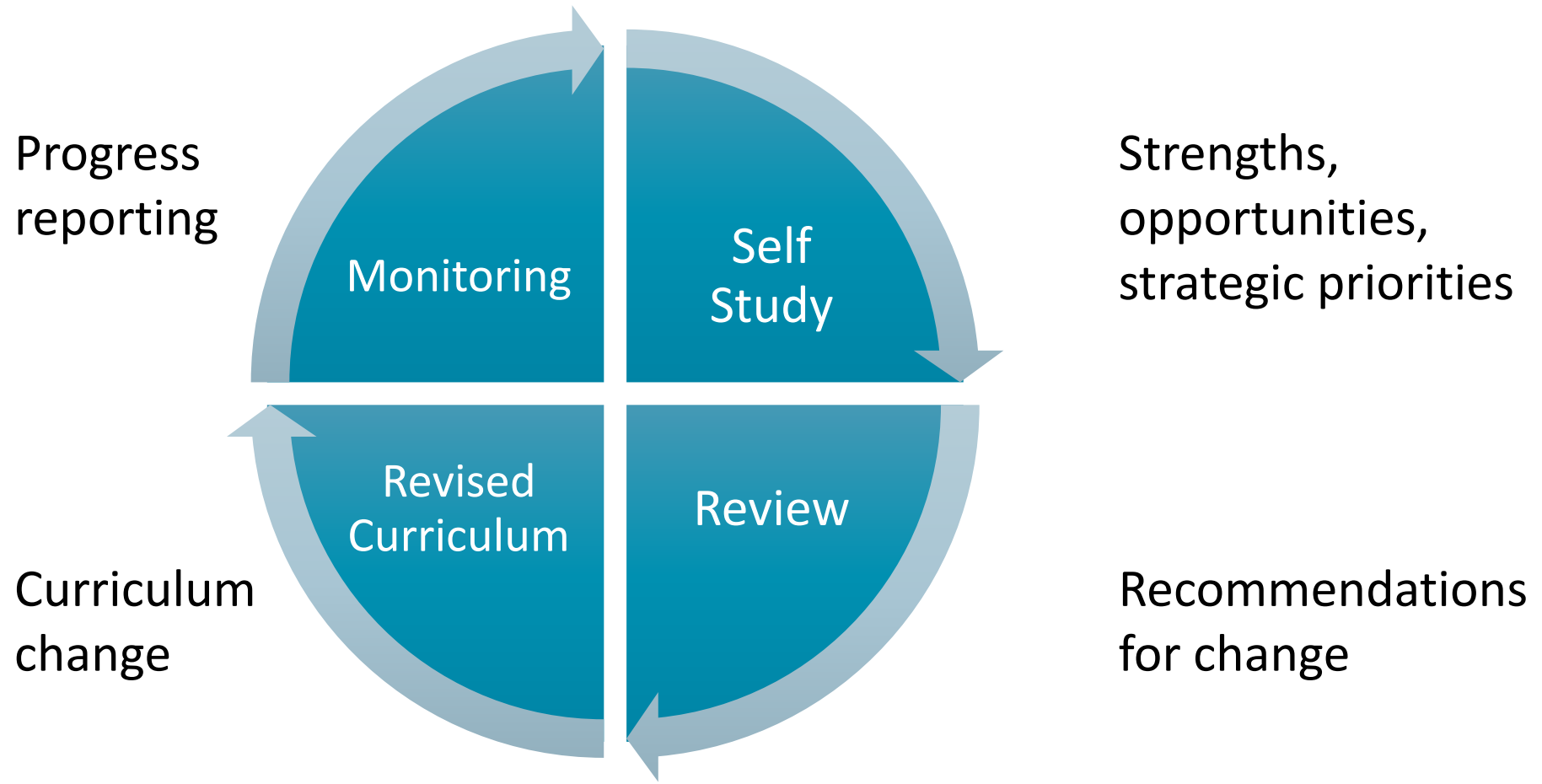

UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO QUALITY ASSURANCE PROCESS (UTQAP)

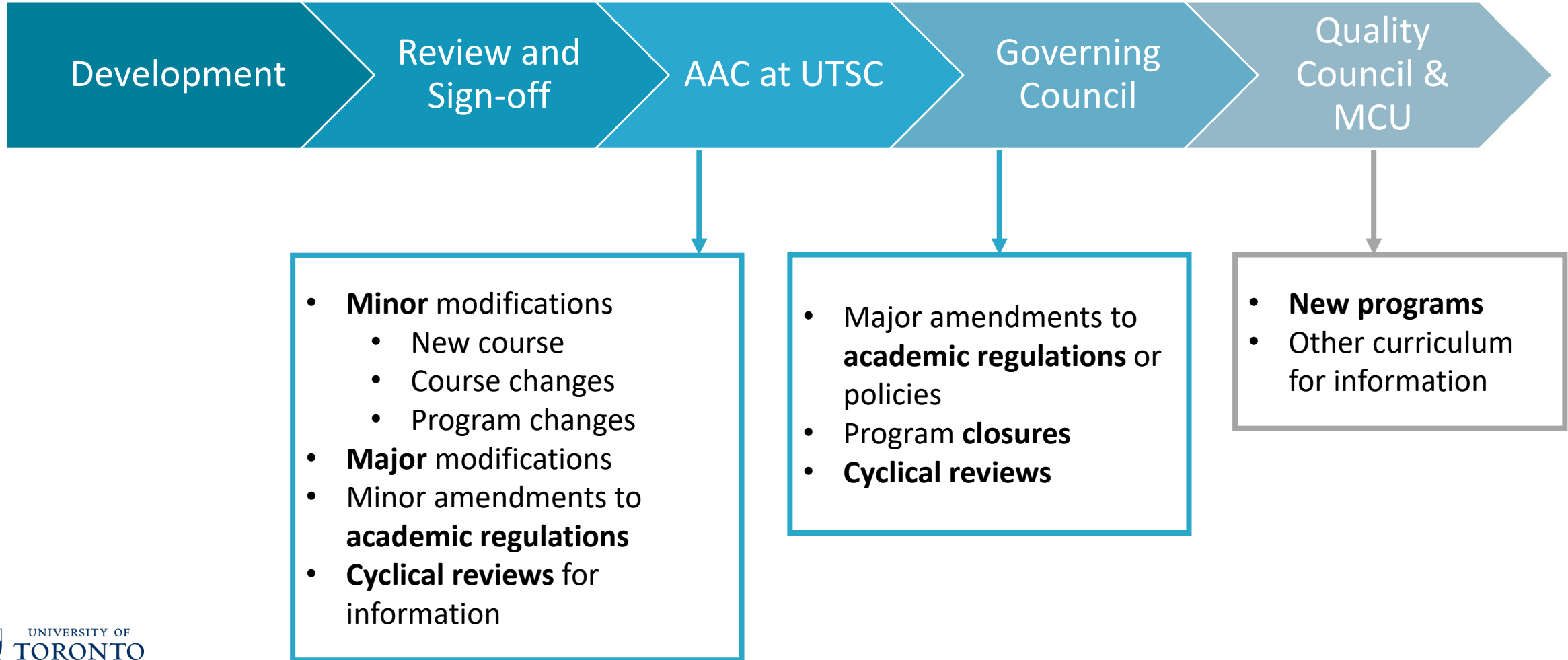
- The UTQAP outlines protocols for:
 - development, appraisal and approval of entirely new academic programs
 - development and approval of proposals to significantly change existing academic programs (major modifications)
 - closure of existing degrees and programs
 - cyclical review of existing Faculties, units and the programs they offer.
- The UTQAP ensures that the University of Toronto operates in conformity with the Quality Assurance Framework (QAF) for the Province of Ontario.
