Strengths

- Leadership in Equity, Diversity, Indigeneity and Inclusion (EDII)

Recommendations

- Determine ideal size for each program
- Modify curriculum to enhance student experience and add opportunities for research and EL
- Assess impact of admissions requirements

- Review minimum grades for admission for minor, and revisit Specialist requirements
- Determine ideal balance of high impact course offerings
- Review available admissions data



Department of Geography, Geomatics and Environment: October 27-28, 2022

Strengths

- Strong programs with large & increasing enrolments
- Programs well linked to research
- Faculty are well supported and distributed
- High overall morale

Recommendations

- Ensure greater overlap between Phys Geog and Env Sci programs
- Refocus Human Geography
 curriculum
- Re-envision research clusters for interdisciplinarity

- Program mini-retreats will examine curriculum and student feedback
- Examine research clusters overall
- Consult with others offering large 100-level courses



Master of Management of Innovation (MMI): July 4-5, 2022

- High overall strength and quality of faculty who are engaged in the program

Recommendations

- Enhance entrepreneurial activity & examine sequence of courses
- Clarify objectives of MMI and IMI
- Strengthen external relationships

- Faculty retreat will review potential for more EL, curriculum changes, and successful new course MMI 2000H
- Expanding admissions in STEM fields
- 2025 Review of IMI and its programs will guide mandate & vision



Master of Science in Sustainability Management (MScSM): Sept 22-23, 2022

- Strong program management and curriculum
- Faculty are excellent and significant contributors

Recommendations

- Enhance clarity of objectives for the program
