Exchange

- Tri-campus partnerships in over 150 destinations around the world
- Includes course-based exchange, research and internships for 1 –3 semesters

Global Classrooms

- Tri-campus virtual opportunities embedded in courses with funding available
- 30 UTM global classrooms to date, new funding call January 27

Summer Abroad

- Tri-campus UofT courses taught on location over the summer
- Managed separately by Woodsworth

UTM Abroad

- UTM specific tailored short-term experiential learning global opportunities
- Curricular and co-curricular options with travel during the study breaks

Key highlights at UTM from 2024-25

- New partnership with Cultural Vistas to help facilitate J1 internships visas for placements in the United States
- New, UTM specific partnership with Roots for **internships**, primarily at non-for-profit organizations, focused on **Africa** with options around the world
- New destinations for UTM Abroad in:
 - Oxford: World Religions and Ecology
 - Japan: Religion and Culture in Japan
 - Thailand: Alternative Tourism
