PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

The annual report for 2022-23 was provided for information to the UTM Academic Affairs Committee on May 6, 2024.

HIGHLIGHTS:

The purpose of the information package is to inform the Academic Affairs Committee of the work of Committee on Standing (COS) specifically providing details concerning the focus of the work, the numbers of cases considered and the outcomes. It is not intended to create a discussion regarding individual cases or their specifics, as they were dealt with by a body, which was bound by due process and fairness. The COS reviews appeals for petitions decisions made by the Office of the Registrar.

The report covers the period between September 1, 2023, to August 31, 2024

The report highlights the types of petitions assessed by the Office of the Registrar, totaling 9153 in the given period.

The COS met 9 times to review 156 appeals; 11 were granted and 145 were refused. In this academic year, 11 appellants submitted 31 appeals to the Academic Appeals Subcommittee in 4 AAS meetings.

The University of Toronto Mississauga Office of the Registrar (OR) adjudicates petition requests on behalf of the Committee on Standing (COS) and coordinates the hearing of first appeals for refused petitions, which are brought before COS members. The committee is comprised of faculty members, the Dean of Student Affairs, and a current UTM student. The Registrar and Assistant Dean, Enrolment Management, serves as the Chair of COS.

Staff in the OR responsible for handling petition requests include the Assistant Registrar, Academic Standards and Petitions, and two Academic Standards and Petitions Coordinators. OR representatives attend COS hearings in a non-voting capacity, with the exception of the Chair.

The report covers the period between September 1, 2023, to August 31, 2024.

Petitions and Committee on Standing - An Overview

- The OR processed 9153 petition requests on behalf of the COS in 2023-24.
- The most requested petition types are as follows:
 - o 38% of all petitions were for First Deferral of Unwritten UTM Examinations
 - o 12% of all petitions were for Late Withdrawal without Academic Penalty
 - 11% of all petitions were for Further Deferral of Unwritten UTM Examinations
 - 11% of all petitions were for Exception to Degree
- The above categories were also the most requested petition types in 2022-23, with the
 exception of Exception to Degree, a petition type that has seen increasing requests in
 recent years. This petition type increased from 642 in 2021-22 to 909 in 2022-23, and
 another to 1045 in 2023-24. Examples of Exception to Degree petitions include requests
 such as third attempts at a passed course, graduating with incomplete requirements, late
 applications of Credit-No Credit (CR/NCR) or Second Attempt for Credit (SAC).

Regular and Deferred Exams

There were approximately 88,724 regular and deferred examinations prepared in the 2023-2024 during the 5 exam periods (December, February, April, June, August). For the April 2024 regular exam period, approximately 38,658 students were scheduled to write of which 37,475 were inperson exams prepared by the OR and the rest were deferred exams or administered by academic units.

Note: In 2019-20, LWDs were not processed in large numbers due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the University's temporary changes in policy to accommodate students. During this time, the last day to drop an S or Y course from the academic record was extended to April 22, 2020.

Committee on Standing Cases

The COS will review a written appeal with new information (not presented in the original petition request) within 90 days of the original petition decision date. All appeals must be heard by the COS before the student can further appeal to the UTM Academic Appeals Subcommittee.

The COS met 9 times to review 156 appeals; 11 were granted and 145 were refused. In this academic year, 11 appellants submitted 31 appeals to the Academic Appeals Subcommittee in 4 AAS meetings.
