




Spigel Hall – Phase II Opening May 2025

- 201m² (2100 ft²) of configurable student space


Spigel Hall – Configurable Student Spaces

- Refreshing campus housing stock, creating welcoming, well-maintained spaces for our residents








Residence Phase IX

- Tracking for completion, September 2026


