



Pulling Back the Curtain on Academic Change

- What happens after?





Minor Modifications

- Retiring courses




Substantial proposals follow some variation of this process





Academic Affairs Committee is the *one and only* governance approval step for:

- New major or specialist, *where there is already a major or specialist*
- New minor program*, *where there is an existing specialist or major*
- Freestanding minor
- New Stream within a program
- Program Focus*
- Cat 2 certificate*

* In policy these are considered *minor modifications*. At UTM we use the same process for development as other program proposals




Program Modification Process





Academic Affairs Committee is the *first* of many approval steps for other proposals
