


2019 – 2025 Total Full-Time Headcount

2019 – 2025 Full-Time Total Headcount


Domestic & International by Legal Status


2019 – 2025 Full-Time Total New Intake








2020 – 2025 New Intake Entrance Award Recipients



2025 Full-Time New Intake by Admission Category




2025 Undergraduate Full-Time Program Enrolment by Regulated and Deregulated Fee Program Types

Note: Cohort refers to a certain starting Academic Year as of the Fall Count Date in which students started their degree. The cohorts include newly admitted, first-time, full-time, bachelor degree seeking students in first entry programs and excludes inbound international exchange students and transfer students. A student is a graduate for a given Academic Year in which that student graduates (e.g., if a student in their fourth year graduates in June, they will be shown as graduated for Academic Year 4).
