The University experienced a tragic loss in 2025 with the homicide of a student. Working in close partnership with law enforcement, our existing camera systems played a key role in supporting a prompt arrest.

In addition to CCTV support, our Campus Safety and Facilities teams contributed significantly throughout the investigation, coordinating access, assisting with information gathering, and working through challenging winter conditions to ensure safe and accessible grounds.

Our dedication to the well-being of all students, faculty, and staff remains steadfast, as reflected in our annual report and will continue moving forward.

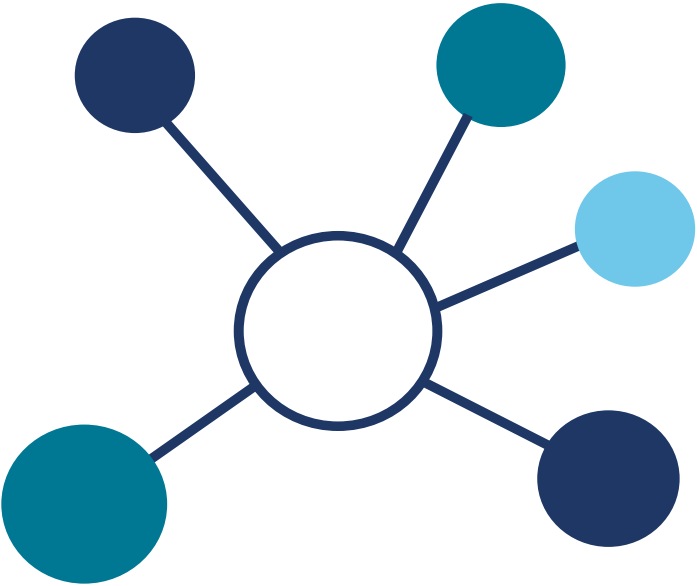

2025 Statistics at a Glance

Campus Safety handled a high volume of community support in 2025,

- **Assist Community Member** calls representing the largest share of activity (578 incidents),
- **Medical Assistance** remained significant due to TPASC's high usage (159 incidents), and
- **Community Crisis Response Coordinator (CCRC)** continues to play a vital role in supporting safety and well-being across our community.
