Candidates in the Governing Council and Academic Board Elections

I have enclosed the results of the 2007 Governing Council and Academic Board Elections.

### **Governing Council Elections**

Ballots for the election of a **teaching staff** member in **Governing Council Constituency IC** (Faculty of Arts and Science: Departments of Astronomy and Astrophysics, Cell and Systems Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Ecology and Evolutionary Biology, Geology, Mathematics, Physics and Statistics and Actuarial Science) have been verified and counted. Professor Ronald Kluger received the greatest number of votes and was declared the winner of the election.

Ballots for the election of a member of the **administrative staff** to the Governing Council have also been verified and counted. Mr. P.C. Choo received the greatest number of votes and was declared the winner of the election.

Voting in the **full-time undergraduate student** election ended on March 9, 2007 and the deadline for filing an intention to appeal has passed. Ms Saswati Deb and Mr. Alex Rascanu had the greatest number of votes and were declared the winners of the election on March 12, 2007.

Voting in the **graduate student** elections also ended on March 9, 2007 and the deadline for filing an intention to appeal has passed. Mr. Alex Kenjeev had the greatest number of votes in **Constituency I** and was declared the winner of the election on March 12, 2007. Mr. Arya Ghadimi had the greatest number of votes in **Constituency II** and was also declared the winner of the election on March 12, 2007.

### **Academic Board Elections**

Ballots for the election of a **teaching staff** member of the Academic Board from the **University of Toronto at Mississauga** have been verified and counted. Dr. Judith Poë received the greatest number of votes and was declared the winner of the election.
