Discontinuation of Admission to the 3-year Degree at the University

of Toronto at Mississauga

On April 6, 2000, the Academic Board approved a recommendation for the discontinuation of the 15-credit B.A. and B.Sc. in the Faculty of Arts and Science. The motion stated that it would be "effective for students first registering in the Faculty of Arts and Science on the St. George Campus in the academic year 2001-2002 and at the University of Misssissauga at a time to be determined by the Vice-President and Provost".

I am writing to report that, pursuant to that recommendation, Principal McNutt and I have agreed that entry to 15-credit B.A.and B.Sc. degrees at the University of Toronto at Mississauga will cease effective September 2003. I will report this for information at the next meeting of the Academic Board.
