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Policy on Emeritus / Emerita Status

The appointment to the rank of Professor Emeritus, Associate Professor Emeritus, Senior Lecturer Emeritus and Librarian Emeritus will be given to Professors, Associate Professors, Senior Lecturers and Librarians who have retired. An individual appointed to these ranks may elect to have the title Professor Emerita, Associate Professor Emerita, Senior Lecturer Emerita or Librarian Emerita. The award of Emeritus or Emerita status to retiring Professors, Associate Professors, Senior Lecturers and Librarians shall be reported for information to the Academic Board of the Governing Council.

Where Professors have also held a named chair, as defined in the *Policy on Endowed Chairs, Professorships, Lectureships and Programs*, they will also be entitled to apply to be able to use the title of that named chair or professorship with the qualifier 'emeritus' or 'emerita'. Such applications will require the approval of the Vice-President and Provost and will be reported for information to the Academic Board of the Governing Council.

Approved by Governing Council on June 23, 2009, effective July 1, 2009, replacing the *Policy on Appointment of Professor Emeritus*
