JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION: Research matters are within the purview of the Committee on Academic Programs and the Academic Board. The Business Board has, however, traditionally been interested in the research enterprise. Having been previously responsible for the University of Toronto Innovations Foundation, the Board has taken a particular interest in the work of the University's Innovations Group.

HIGHLIGHTS: The Vice-President, Research has taken the opportunity this year to develop an Annual Report format comprised of two parts. Together they provide the same information as previous versions, however, the information is now separated into profiles of excellence, innovation and leadership in research at the University of Toronto and highlights distinguished scholars. The second brochure presents excellence in research 'by the numbers'.
