The Academic Board of the Governing Council is composed of 117 members, 48 of whom are elected teaching staff. The Board is concerned with matters affecting the teaching, learning, and research functions of the University, the establishment of University objectives and priorities, the development of long-term and short-term plans, and the effective use of resources in the course of these pursuits. The Board is responsible for approving matters such as research policy, budget guidelines and annual budgets, the establishment of new academic programs, admissions and awards policies, and academic discipline.
