Be It Resolved

(i) Subject to the understanding that the rates of the University College residence ancillary operation are increased sufficiently to ensure that the operation continues to recover its own costs,

THAT the Business Board concur with the prospective recommendation of the Academic Board for approval in principle of the University College Residence project, and specifically the recommendation,

THAT the project cost of \$22,000,000 be approved, with the funding sources as follows:

- (i) Donation from University College of \$2,500,000
- (ii) University College Residence Ancillary allocation of \$1,485,000
- (iii) University College Food Service allocation of \$800,000
- (iv) University Infrastructure Investment Fund allocation of \$70,000, and
- (v) Financing in the amount of \$17,145,000 to be repaid from residence fee revenues over a 25-year amortization period at 8% per annum; and
- (ii) THAT the Vice-President, Business Affairs be authorized to execute the University College Residence project at a cost not to exceed \$22,000,000 and to arrange such interim and long-term financing as required, from either internal or external sources.
