Health and Safety Requirements – Quarterly Report on Compliance

The Business Board is responsible for monitoring health and safety compliance.

**GOVERNANCE PATH:**

**PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:**

Professor Hildyard has undertaken to provide the Business Board with quarterly reports on the University's compliance with legal requirements in the area of Health and Safety.

**HIGHLIGHTS:**

**1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) Visits and Orders**

During this reporting period (April 1 – August 31, 2013) the Ministry of Labour visited the University four times.

One visit related to a student critical injury at UTM. No orders issued.

Two follow up visits, one at UTM and one at St George, related to employee complaints. No orders issued.

One visit at St. George related to an employee non-critical injury. Orders were issued and all have been complied with.

## **2. Regulatory Visits**

On June 11-12, 2013, CNSC inspectors visited the Rotman Faculty of Management to verify the activities of a contractor performing a gamma radiography on a construction site. No issues were found.

On August 26 and 27 CNSC officers performed a type II inspection of our radioactive waste facilities. Three minor administrative issues were noted. All have been complied with.

## **3. Incidents Abroad Relating to Students**

The Safety Abroad Office has noted 4 incidents relating to students abroad from January 1 to September 1 2013.
