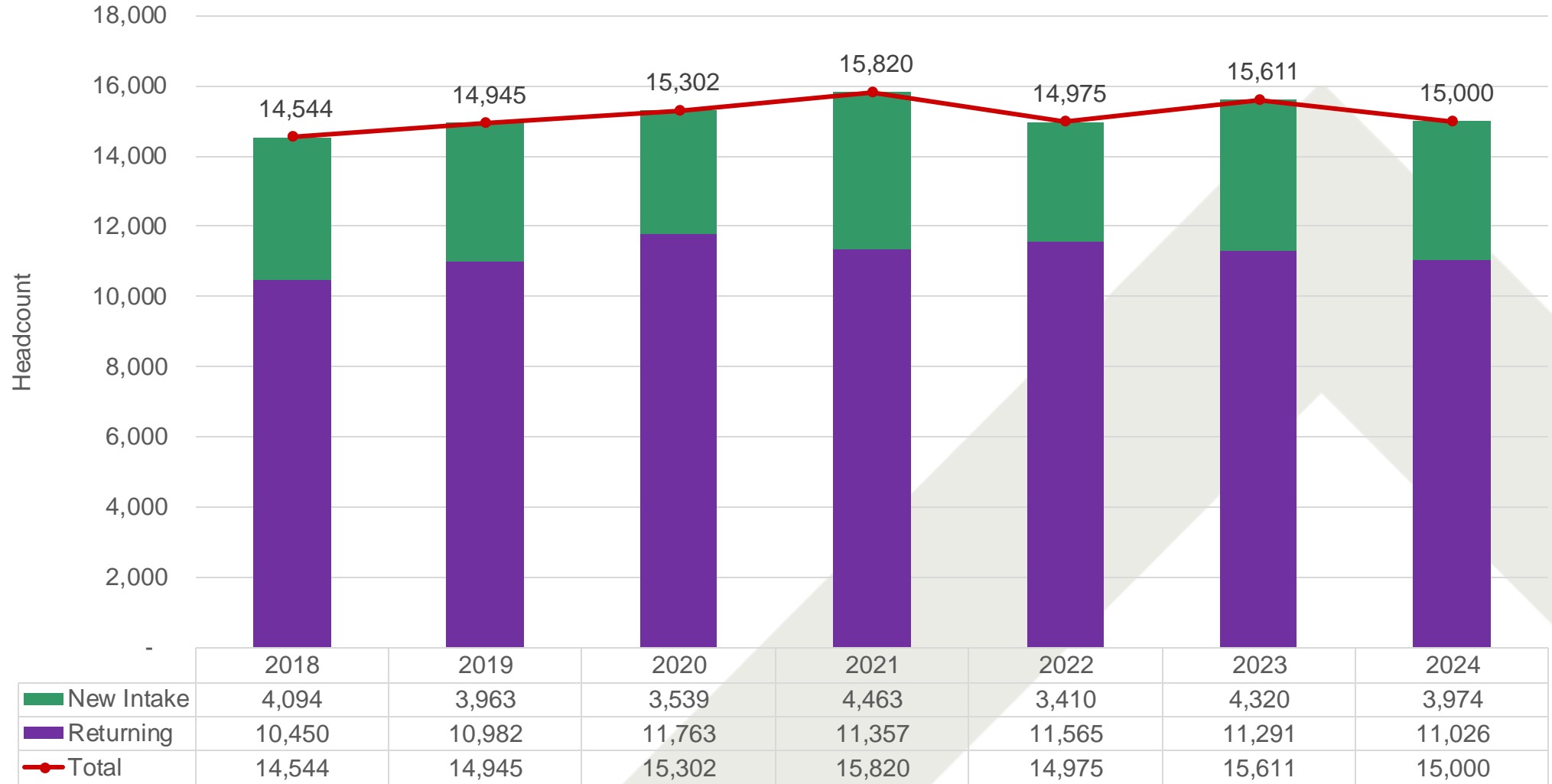

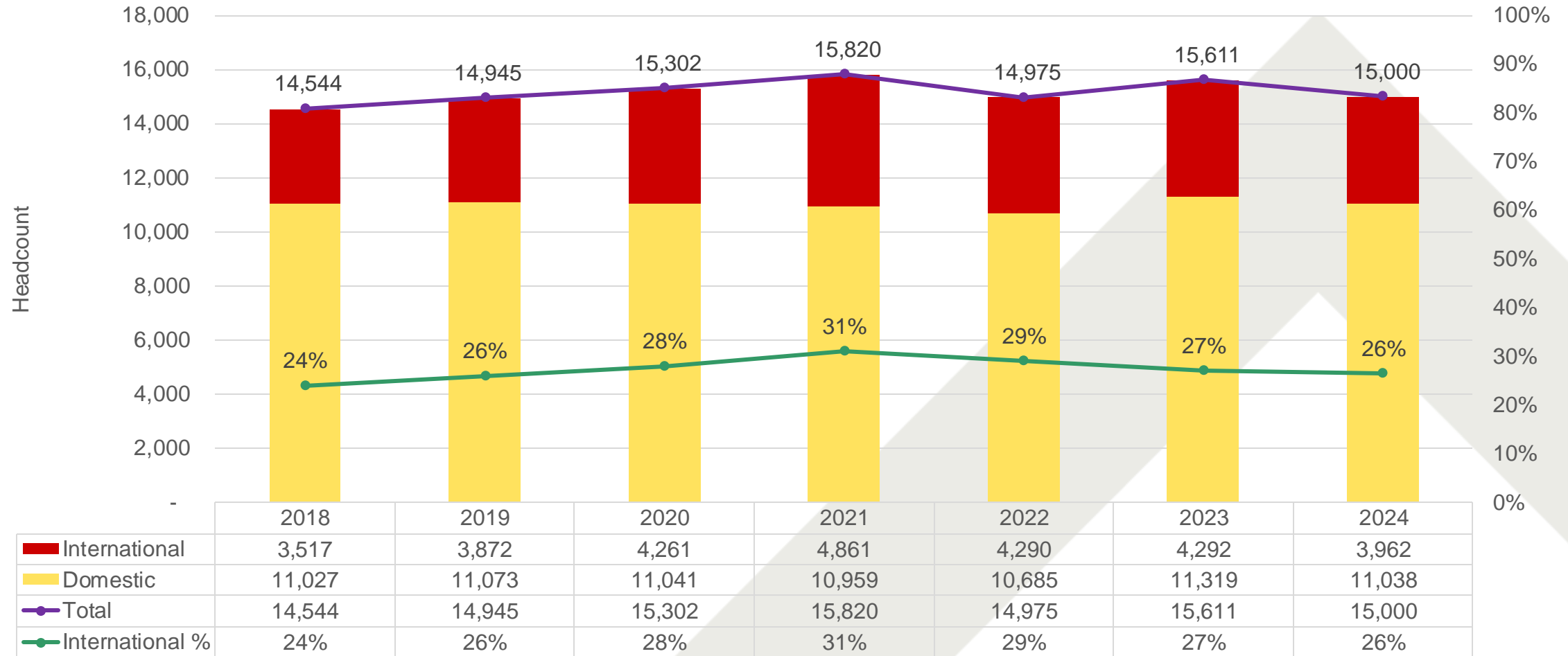


# 2018 – 2024 Total Full-Time Headcount

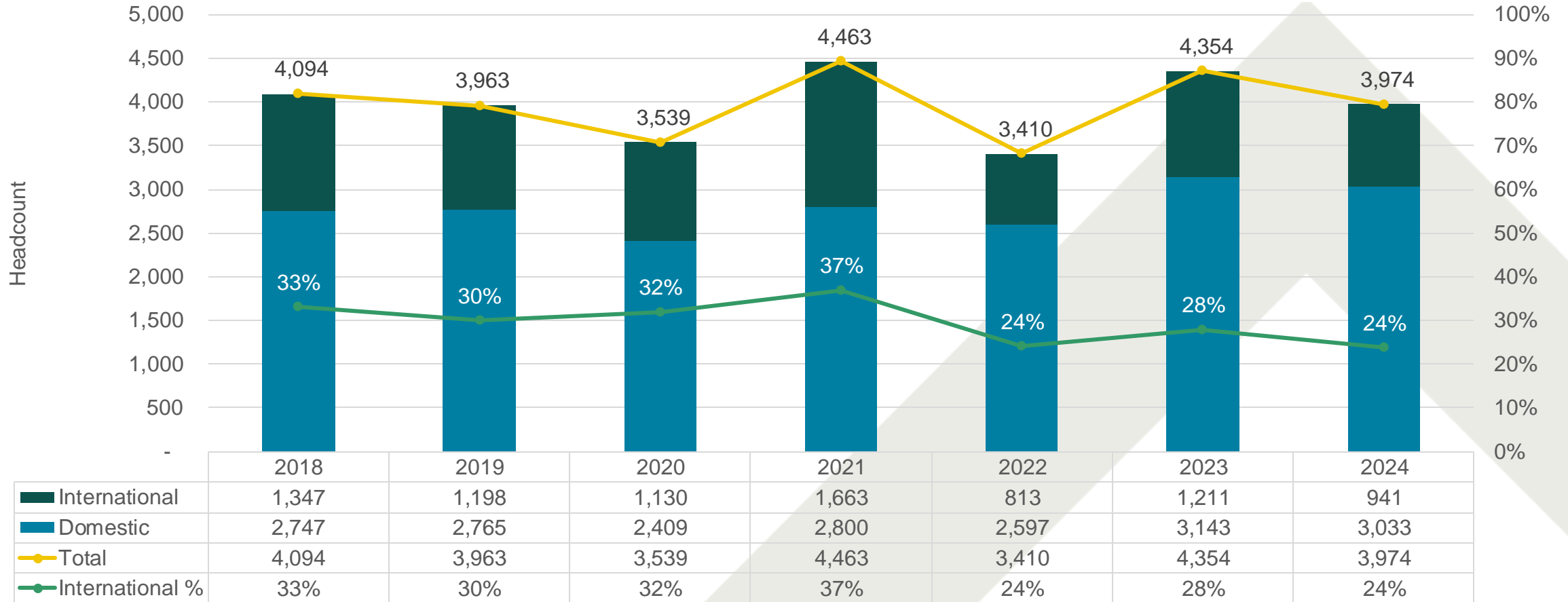
# 2018 – 2024 Full-Time Total Headcount Domestic & International by Legal Status



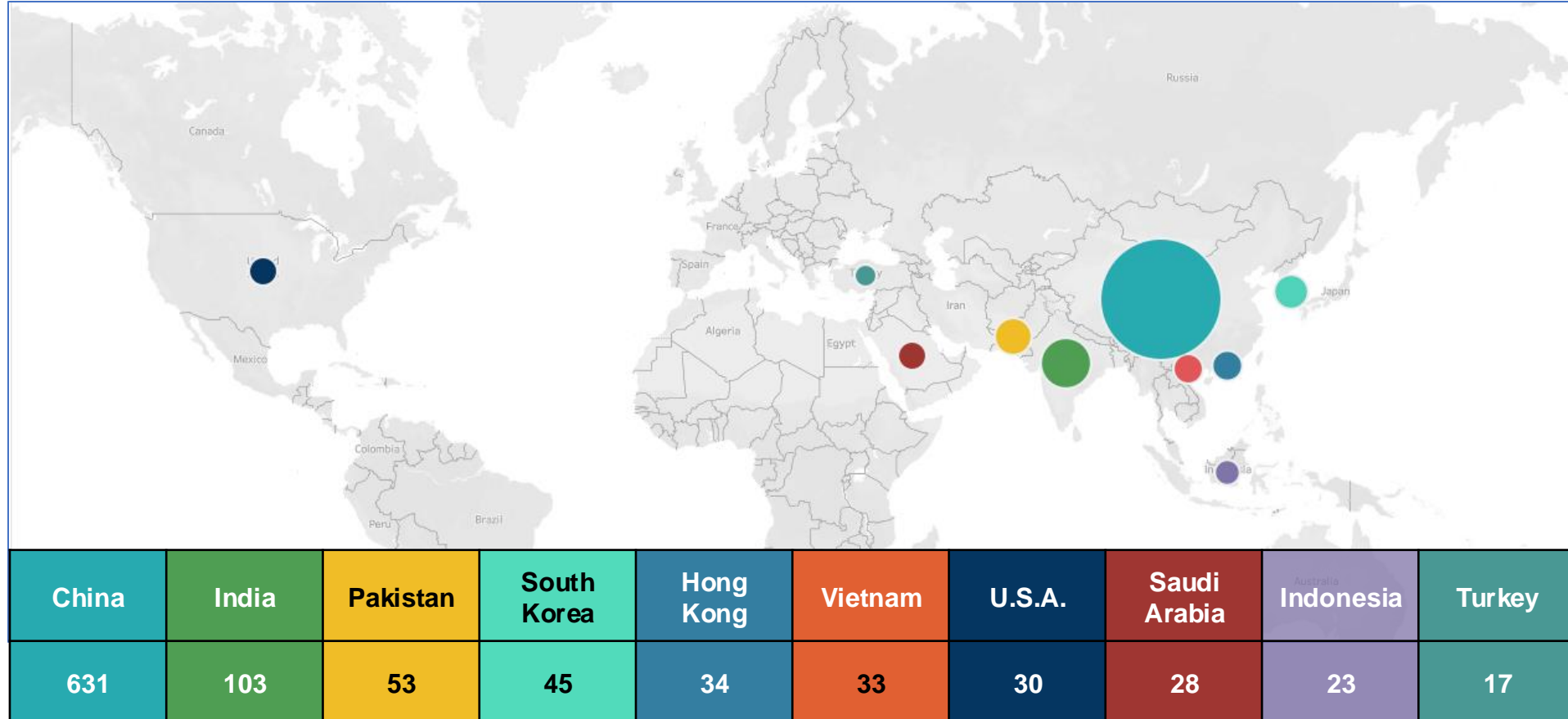

## Domestic & International by Legal Status

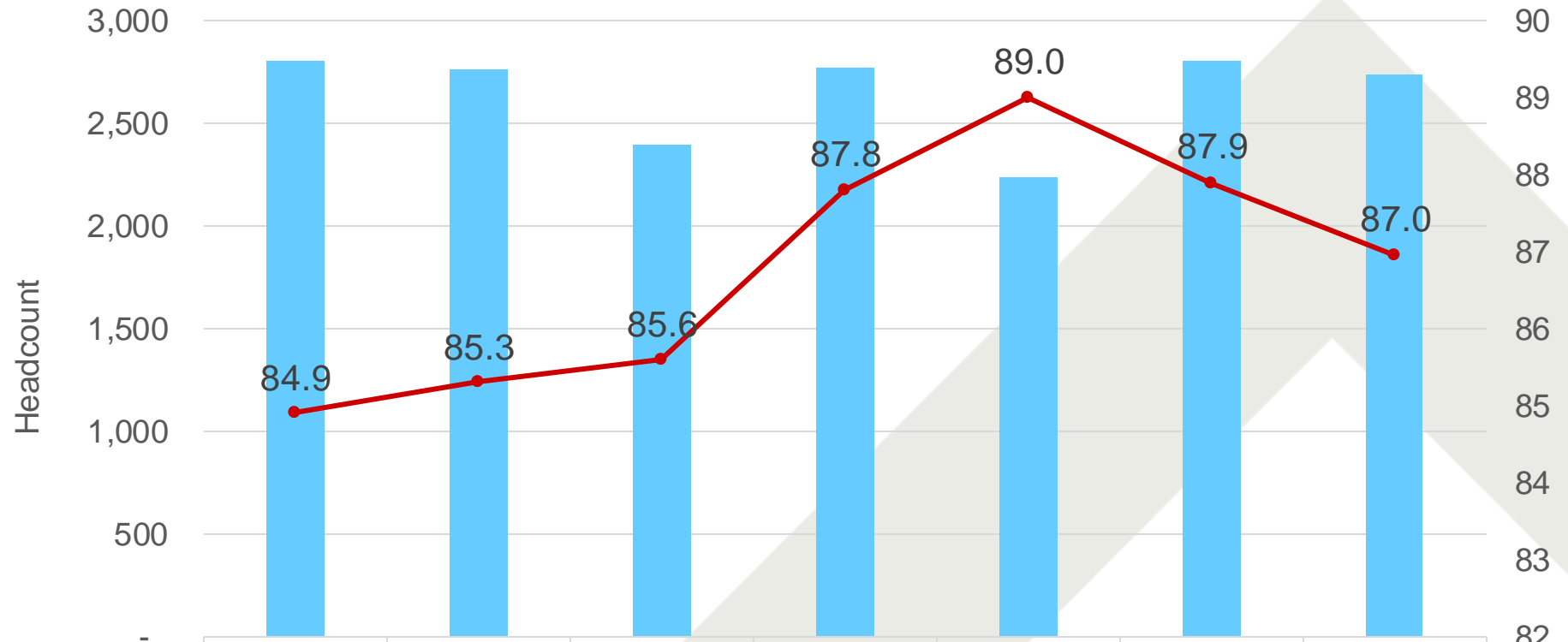


# 2024 Full-Time New Intake by Country of Citizenship (Top 10 after Canada)

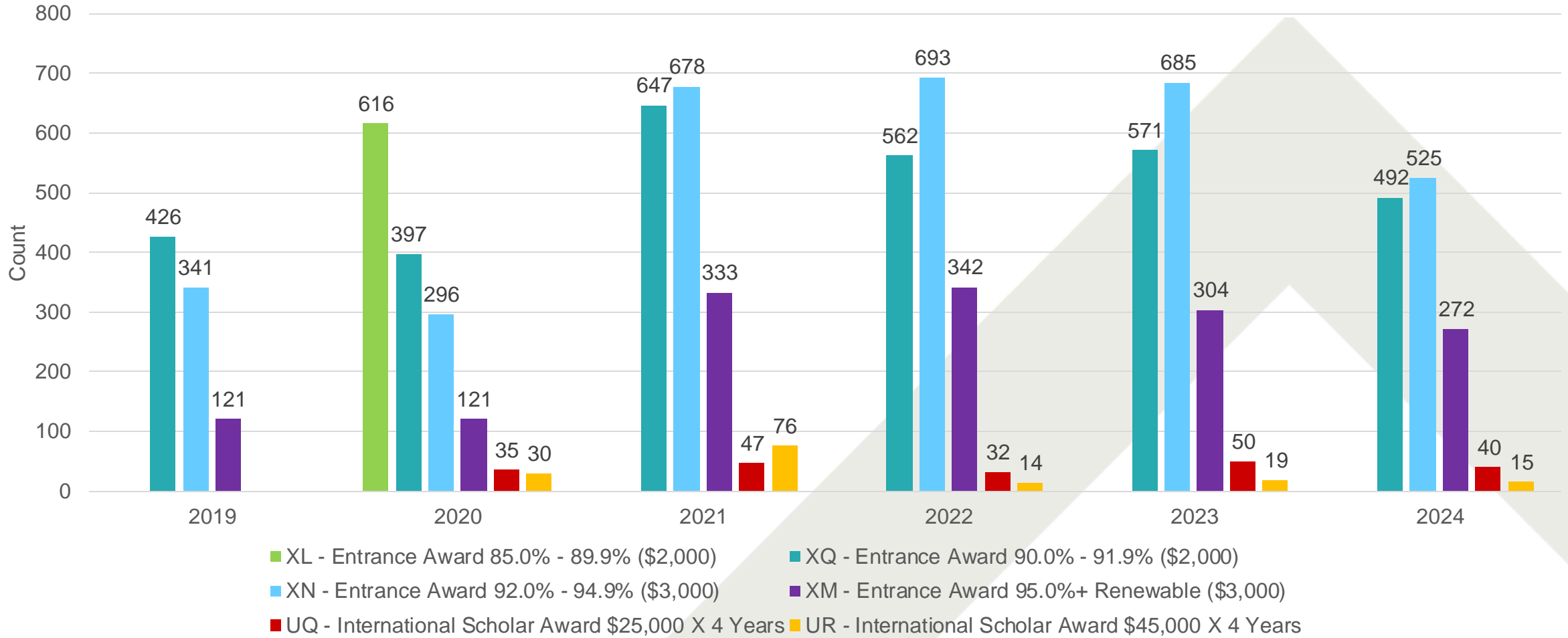

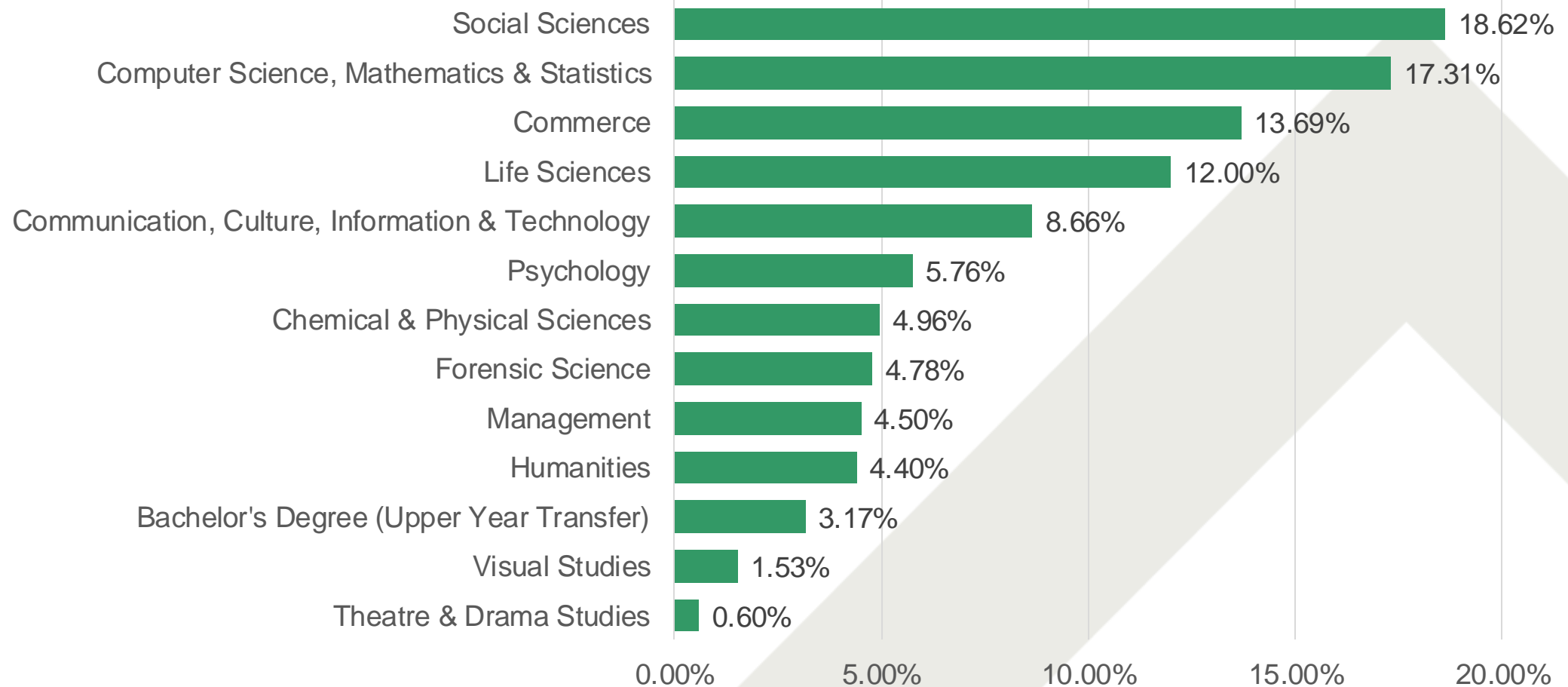

# 2019 – 2024 New Intake Entrance Award Recipients

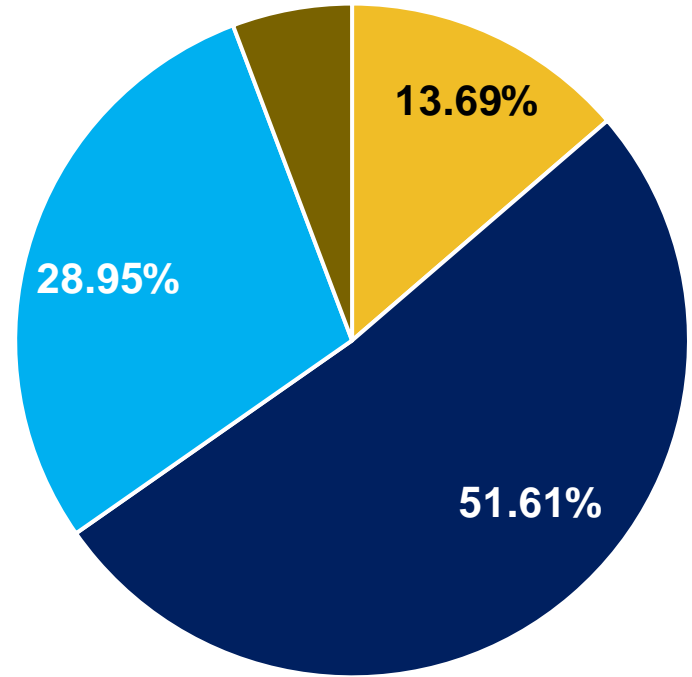


# 2024 Full-Time New Intake by Admission Category





# 2024 Undergraduate Full-Time Program Enrolment by Regulated and Deregulated Fee Program Types



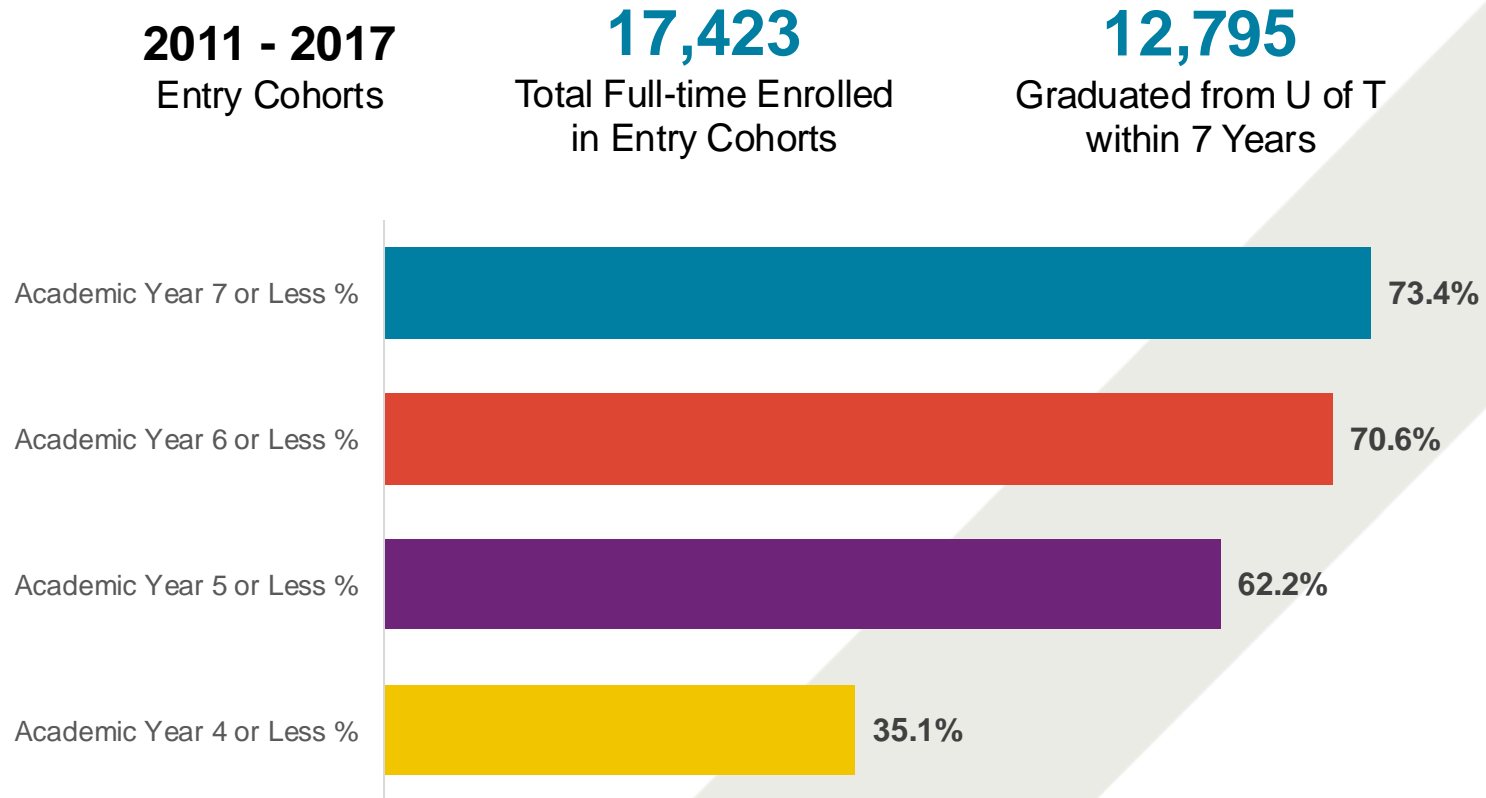
- Combined a Deregulated with a Regulated program

The cohorts include newly admitted, first-time, full-time, bachelor degree seeking students in first entry programs and excludes inbound international exchange students and transfer students. A student is a graduate for a given Academic Year in which that student graduates (e.g., if a student in their fourth year graduates in June, they will be shows as graduated for Academic Year 4).
