Dear Mr. S.

At its hearing on Wednesday, August 5, 1981 the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

that in or about December, 1978, you did falsify an academic record of the University of Toronto, namely, your application for admission to the University of Toronto Faculty of Dentistry, and you did utter or make use of such falsified record for the purpose of gaining admission to the said Faculty of Dentistry, contrary to Section E.1(c) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.

I am writing to formally advise you of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to this charge. Based on the evidence presented, the jury found you to be guilty of the charge.

The jury recommended that the following sanctions be imposed and gave the following reason for recommending these sanctions:

- (i) that you receive a one year suspension from the university commencing the Fall of 1981 (in order to reevaluate your academic goals and professional career);
- (ii) that you receive no academic credit for the 1980/81 academic year (as punishment for falsifying your application form for admission to the Faculty of Dentistry);

(iii) that notice of these sanctions be recorded on your academic transcript for a period of three years (for the protection of other universities and in order that you may graduate with a 'clear' record from the University of Toronto).

The jury did not recommend expulsion because in its opinion part of the blame for the situation reaching this point rested with the Admissions Office of the Faculty of Dentistry.

I am enclosing information regarding rights of appeal and would draw your attention to the fact that the deadline for filing an appeal is August 28, 1981.

At its hearing on August 6, 1981 the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That you did falsify an academic record of the University of Toronto, being an application for admission dated May 6, 1980, and you did make use of such falsified record for the purpose of gaining admission to the University of Toronto for the academic year 1980-1981, contrary to s. E.1(c) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.

I am writing to formally advise you of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to this charge. The jury found you to be guilty of the charge and recommended that you receive a caution in this matter. In recommending this sanction, the jury commented that given the minimal nature of the offence, a caution would be sufficient.

I am enclosing information regarding rights of appeal and would draw your attention to the fact that the deadline for filing an appeal is September 4, 1981.
