THE MEETING WAS HELD IN CLOSED SESSION

1. Mr. A.

An appeal by Mr. A, a student in the Master of Music programme in the School of Graduate Studies was heard by the Subcommittee on Academic Appeals on June 23rd, 1975, as outlined in Report Number 15. The Subcommittee agreed that Mr. A'S appeal be allowed and that he be permitted to re-write an essay on "Schoenberg's Chamber Symphony No.2", and submit it by September 30th, 1975, for the course in Music 4200. The Subcommittee further agreed that if Mr. A obtained a B grade on the essay, he would achieve a passing grade in the course and would satisfy the requirements for the Master of Music degree.

On October 2nd, 1975, the Subcommittee received a request for an extension of the time for completion of the paper. After consideration of the documentary and oral evidence, including the information that the Graduate Department of Music was prepared to recommend that an extension be granted provided the new deadline be considered final,

YOUR SUBCOMMITTEE AGREED

THAT the time for submission of Mr. A'S paper on "Schoenberg's Chamber Symphony No.2" be extended to 10:00 a.m. on Monday, November 17th, 1975, on the understanding that this date would be final and not subject to further extension.
