THE MEETING WAS HELD IN CLOSED SESSION

1. Mr. V.

At its meeting on Wednesday, November 16th, 1977, the Academic Appeals Board heard the appeal of Mr. V. from a decision of the Applications and Memorials Committee of the School of Graduate Studies, upholding the decision of the Graduate Department of Mechanical Engineering in January, 1976 to retract its acceptance of the appellant into the Master's Programme because of his unsatisfactory work. The appellant had been granted provisional registration in October, 1975 but had not completed the registration process. He did not write examinations in the two courses he was attending and his work on his project had become unsatisfactory. On the evidence before the Board there was no basis to doubt the Department's decision.

The Board's decision is that the appeal should be dismissed.
